Thursday October 9

The Transportation Technology Center (TTC) near Pueblo Colorado is a world class facility offering a wide range of unique capabilities for research, development, testing,

consulting, and training for railway-related technologies. A 52 square mile facility, TTC is isolated and secure with a vast array of specialized testing facilities and tracks. The site also enables testing of all types of freight and passenger rolling stock, vehicle and track components, and safety devices. The Union Pacific Railroad Steam Shop in Cheyenne, Wyoming is home to two of the largest operating steam locomotives in the world. We'll tour the roundhouse and, if we're lucky, can observe one of the locomotives under steam.
