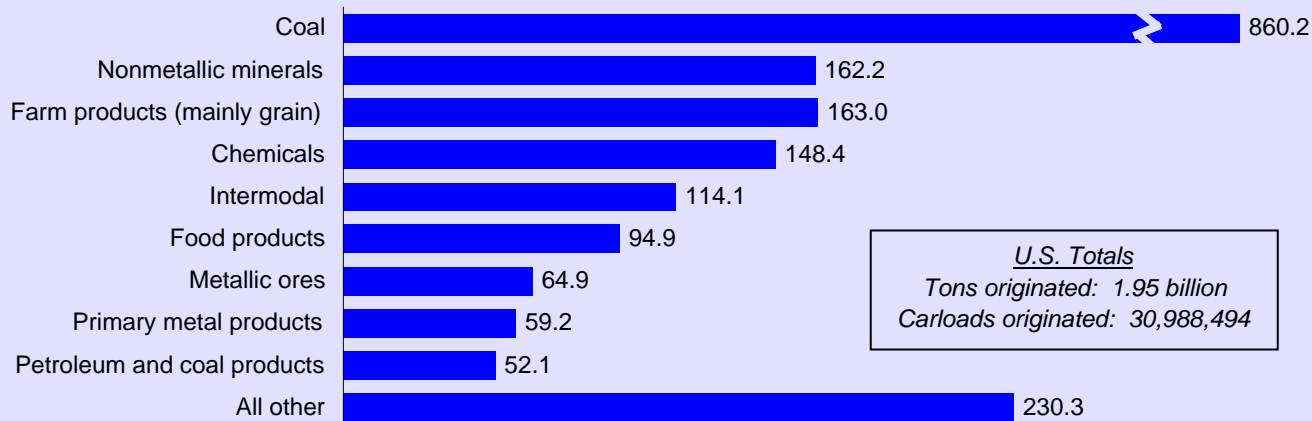

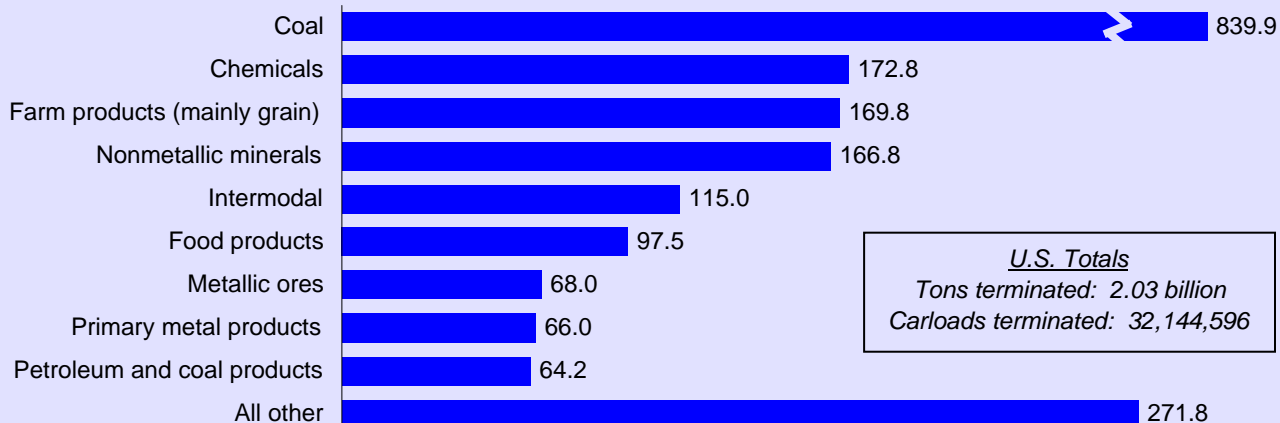

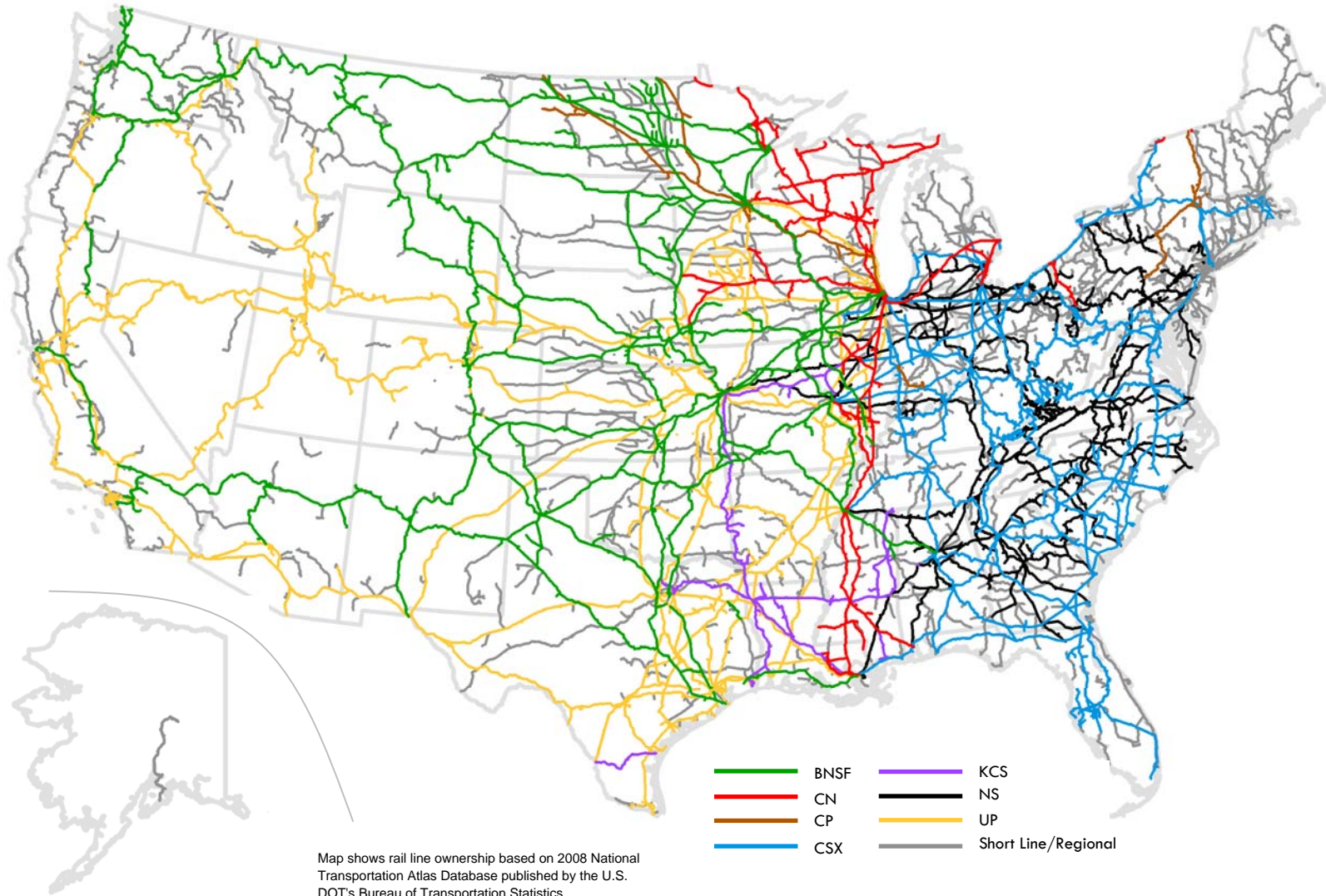
Tons Originated in United States in 2007 (millions)
