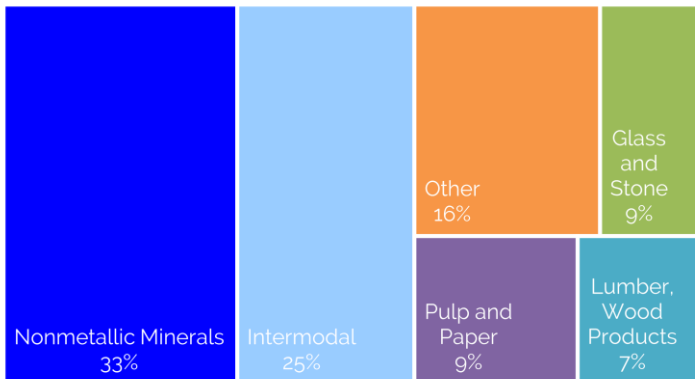


Sustainability:

Rail Traffic Originated in 2019 Total Tons: 40.9 million Total Carloads: 1,082,600

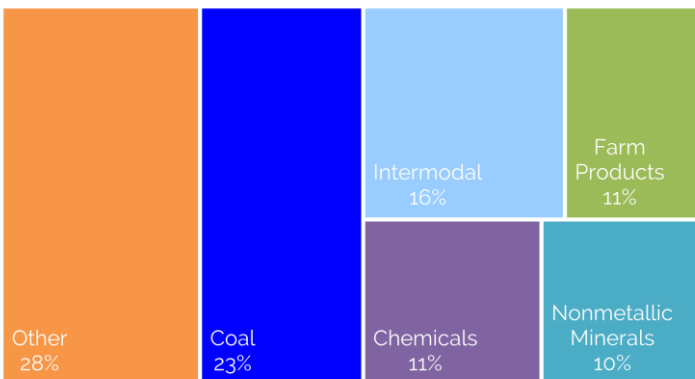
